

1 School hours, recess and lunchtime

School hours

School hours for TPO and IPS are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday: 8.30-12.00 and 13.00-15.00. Wednesday: 8.30-12.30 am. The HB groups have a continuous timetable. School hours for these groups are from 08.30-14.30 (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday). On Wednesdays from 08.30-12.30.

Children may enter the school from 8.15 in the morning. For TPO, at 8.25, the bell rings. This is the signal for you as a parent to leave school so that lessons can start on time. Children who do not stay over are welcome back in the schoolyard from 12.45 pm. For IPS we expect children to be in school by 8.30am.

We ask you to bring your child(ren) on time so that lessons are not disrupted by children arriving late. When collecting your child(ren), we ask you to wait outside the school until the children come out. To make an appointment with the teacher, please contact him/her via the parent portal of Social Schools. Did you not receive login details for this? If so, please contact the secretariat at info@g-s-v.nl.

Break

At break time, there is a time in each group to eat fruit and/or have something to drink. We assume that pupils bring healthy food and drinks.

Lunchtime

At lunchtime, children can stay over or go home. Children staying over are looked after in the classroom by childcare staff. Children bring their own lunch with them. After-school childcare is organised by the coordinator for after-school childcare, Mrs Gizem Gungor. She can be reached at g.gungor@g-s-v.nl.





2 Parking bicycles at school

Many pupils come by bicycle. We make the following arrangements with them about parking their bikes:

Main building location, Sweelinck Avenue:

Sweelinck Avenue The pupils of groups 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 (TPO) can park their bikes at the back of the school. They can enter through the main entrance via the main square.

Location The Componist, Chopin Avenue:

Pupils of groups 1 on Chopin Avenue (TPO) can park their bikes near the building.

Location HB, Hora Siccamasingel:

Pupils from the Highly Gifted (HB) department can park their bikes near the building on Hora Siccamasingel.

Location IPS, Rijksstraatweg, Haren:

Pupils of International Primary School (IPS) can park their bicycles at the front of the main building.

Due to limited parking facilities, we ask students living close to the school to come to school on foot. The school is not liable for missing or damaged bicycles.

3 Car parking at school

We want to ensure a safe school environment for all our pupils and as little nuisance as possible for local residents around school. Therefore, we would like to make the following arrangements with you about parking cars around our locations. We also ask you to inform others who sometimes take over fetching or dropping off from you, such as grandparents, babysitters or others, about this as best you can.

Sweelinck Avenue/Chopin Avenue

In the morning between 8.05 and 8.35 a.m. and in the afternoon between 2.45 and 3.05 p.m., the Sweelicklaan and thus also the Chopinlaan will be closed to cars. This has been decided in cooperation with the Haydnschool and the municipality of Groningen to improve traffic safety at the entrances to the schools.

You can park on Helperzoom, Helperbrink, Beethovenlaan and Savornin Lohmanlaan. Strausslaan also often has parking space. You will then only have to walk a little further to school. The Helpman and Coendersborg districts are paid-parking zones. Beethovenlaan has a Kiss&Ride lane where you can let children get in and out. You may stop here for this purpose, but NOT park. Parking at the garage boxes behind Beethovenlaan/Strausslaan is prohibited. This is private property. Parking near the gym on Chopinlaan is permitted only in the marked spaces. Parking in the Sweelincklaan/Chopinlaan bend is not permitted. One-way traffic for cars applies in some streets.

Finally, the roads around our school buildings on Sweelinck Avenue and Chopin Avenue are all 30km roads. We ask you to keep to the speed limit here and be alert to pupils who have to cross here.

Rijksstraatweg

Parking is available on the Esserberg (Be Quick) grounds. You can then walk behind the stands to the school buildings. A small bridge has been built to easily reach the school via Esserberg.

We also ask you to park responsibly, keep enough space free for through traffic, do not block pedestrian crossings, do not park in curves, on green spaces or on the pavement and keep the garage plazas clear. Our school's traffic committee constantly monitors safety and takes action when necessary.



From year 1 we ask pupils to bring sports shoes and from year 2, a full gym kit.

Fountain pen

We give a fountain pen to all pupils from group 4 onwards (TPO). We make sure that they use these carefully. Lost or destroyed pens must be replaced through the school itself. The fountain pens cost €3.50 each and can be purchased from teacher Monique Knevelbaard (m.knevelbaard@g-s-v.nl).

5 Speeches and performances

Speaking engagements

From grade 4 onwards (TPO and HB), pupils are required to do a speaking engagement every year. This teaches them to speak in public, in front of a group. We also want to use this to teach pupils independence.

Group performance

Groups 2 to 7 put on a performance once a year. This may consist of, for example, rehearsed pieces, improvisations or musical performances. The pupils perform for fellow pupils in the lower, middle or upper school classes. Parents are welcome to attend these performances. Brothers and/or sisters may also come and watch in consultation with the group teacher.

Musical

Group 8 (TPO) students and HB Group 8 students bid farewell to our school with a musical at the end of the year. At IPS all students perform a musical or share their work through a performance or show with parents each year.



6 Gymnastics

Group 1 and 2 (TPO) and Foundation 1 to Year 1 (IPS)

The youngest pupils receive PE lessons in the playrooms in school. TPO pupils at the Sweelincklaan site and IPS pupils at the Rijksstraatweg site. Pupils of Y1/2 (IPS) have a lesson in the playroom once a week and once a week in the main gymnasium. We recommend that you provide gym shoes with a non-slip sole and Velcro or elastic. The shoes can stay at school.

Clothing

Gym wear is compulsory for pupils in these groups: easy-fitting gym clothes and gym shoes marked with name. From Group 6 (TPO and HB), Year 5 (IPS) onwards, a towel for showering/ freshening up is also compulsory.





7 Activities at lunchtime and after school

Between October and May, from group 3 onwards, we organise various extra activities at lunchtime and after school. The activities are given by internal and external subject teachers, by SKSG (Stichting Kinderopvang Stad Groningen) and by the playground association 'De Helpen'. Some activities charge a fee.

For IPS students there are bilingual afterschool activities organised through SKSG in the form of Kids International.

There are also some afterschool activities organised through the school which this year include: Dutch, Violin, Art and crafts and Yoga.

If there is sufficient interest, language courses in Spanish, German, French, Russian, Chinese (Mandarin), Turkish.


Days off lower school

Pupils in the junior classes attend school for too many hours due to the equalised start and end times. These are groups 1 to 4 of TPO, groups Foundation 1 to Year 3 of IPS and groups 3 and 4 of HB. We are therefore giving them seven extra days off, on which you must provide your own childcare.

In the new school year, these students are free on the following days: 26 September 2025, 18 November 2025, 19 February 2026, 11 March 2026, 17 April 2026, 26 May 2026 and 22 June 2026.

Days off all pupils

Due to staff study days, all pupils are off on the following that: 26 September 2025, 18 November 2025, 2 February 2026 and 2 April 2026.

Treat

Birthday pupils are allowed treats at school. It is all about fun and a healthy alternative to sweets is our preference.

Invitations

Invitations for birthdays should not be handed out at school. We want to save the uninvited children a disappointment by doing this.



12 Head lice

Protocol

We have drawn up a protocol stating how we act if we find head lice in school. If head lice is found in your child's group, we will inform you by e-mail or through the parent portal. We will then ask you to treat your child appropriately at home. If symptoms persist in a particular group or pupil, we will involve the Emergency Service.

Lice Detection Team

The protocol also states, that we conduct a check for head lice after every holiday. For this purpose, our school has a Lice Detection Team (LOT) that regularly checks students for head lice throughout the school year.

Lice bag

All pupils receive a lice bag on which their name is written. Students can hang their coats in this lice bag on the coat rack.





13 Found clothing and items

We ask you to mark your child(ren)'s clothes, school and gym bags, footwear and other belongings with a name. If anything is lost, please enquire with the caretaker, who manages the collection of found clothing and items.

We keep found clothes for one month. After that, the clothes are displayed for two days. We announce this through the parent portal. Clothing that is not collected we give to a charity.

Other items we keep until the summer holidays and also give to a charity after the school year.

14 Parent portal Social Schools

As soon as your son or daughter is 4 years or older and assigned to a group, you will receive a login code for the parent portal Social Schools by e-mail. Through the parent portal, you will receive news items (general and per group), photos and documents. The parent portal is also used for scheduled contact evenings.

15 Mobile phones pupils

As far as we are concerned, it is not necessary for a student to bring his or her mobile phone/smartwatch to school. Indeed, during school hours from 08:15 to 15:00, pupils cannot use their brought devices. Upon entering the group, students must turn in their cell phone or smartwatch to the teacher. This is also outlined in our policy. The school is not liable for loss, theft or damage of devices brought by the pupil.

16 Liability and insurance

Liability

Parents are liable for their children even during the time the children are at school. Teachers or other persons, such as day-care staff, cannot be held liable in case of alleged damage. Parents must pay for any damage caused by their child themselves. We recommend taking out liability insurance with adequate cover for this purpose.

Collective accident insurance

The school has collective accident insurance for all pupils. This means that your child is insured for many things during school hours, during lunchtime, on the way home to school and from school to home. During trips we organise as a school, all pupils and supervisors are always insured. This is basic insurance. This insurance pays out in case of disability, in case of death and for costs of medical and dental treatment, but not for material damage to, for example, glasses, clothing or a bicycle. If you want to insure for more items or a higher amount, you must do so on your own initiative. Our insurance policy can be viewed through the administration.

Replacement

If the regular teacher is absent, he/she is replaced by another teacher from a pool of substitute teachers. We aim to use the same substitute for a group as much as possible. We inform all substitutes in detail about our school in advance. We use a logbook and weekly planning for our lessons, which allows a substitute to continue the lessons as much as possible. If a substitute is not available unexpectedly, the upper school team leader looks for a solution internally or takes other measures. Sporadically, a group may have to stay home. You will be notified via an emergency message on SocialSchools.

Trainees

We think it is important to give future colleagues the opportunity to learn from the way we teach. That is why every year a number of students from a Pedagogical Academy for Primary Education (Hanzehogeschool Groningen and Stenden Hogeschool Assen) do their internships at our school. Foreign interns and students from the International PABO in Meppel regularly join the IPS. Lio interns may also work at the GSV every year. Their internship usually lasts half a year.

18 Company emergency response

We have a number of in-house emergency response workers (BHV'ers) at school who are the point of contact in case of emergencies and accidents. They have completed a basic course for this purpose and receive refresher training every year. The coordinator of the FAFS officers is also the school's safety coordinator/prevention officer, Mr Edgar Been.
